Mr Paul Williams (1st Dan) manages Samurai Olympic Judo Club which is the oldest club in Wales and was founded in 1957.

We are delighted that Mr Williams has offered to teach Judo for 1 hour, each day during the week beginning 24th July. The lessons will be available to all children 4 years and over.

He will supply the necessary clothes for the children. If your child is interested in having a go please can you confirm their height to ensure he brings the correct uniform.

This is an excellent introduction into the sport which commences with children learning to fall and roll.

Children who wish to take part will need to bring shorts and a T Shirt to wear underneath the Judo gear. Long hair will need to be tied back.
